## *Creating History at Batu Ampar*

**W**ITH so much work pouring into Batam's heavy fabrication yards we sometimes take for granted the huge and oddly shaped steel structures we see rising out of the dust (or maybe that should be slush this month) at places like Tanjung Uncung and Batu Ampar.

And those of us not directly involved sometimes fail to appreciate the sophisticated technical skills of the Expats running the jobs and the thousands of local Indonesian workers making it happen.

Dominating the the Batu Ampar landscape at the moment is the massive North Rankin B jacket being built for Woodside at the J Ray McDermott yard.

The jacket is a key component of a second platform on the North Rankin field and part of an AUD\$5 billion investment to boost gas recovery from the North Rankin and Perseus fields. It will allow Woodside and its Australian North-west Shelf partners to access another 7 trillion cubic feet of gas and extend the life of the fields.

The new platform is scheduled to start up in 2013 and when complete will be one of the world's largest

integrated decks. At something over 22,000 tonnes it also will be the largest jacket fabricated in the McDermott yards.

Rankin B will stand in about 125 metres of water and will include further gas compression facilities to boost recovery from the low-pressure fields, as well as new accommodation facilities and utilities. As illustgratd above it will be connected to the existing North Rankin A platform by a bridge and the two will be operated as a single integrated entity.

Woodside operates the North West Shelf Venture on behalf of partners BHP Billiton, BP, Chevron, Shell and Japan's Mimi. All have an equal 16.67% stake in the venture off Australia's remote north-west coastline.
